



Member Spotlight


Meet Linda Jacques RN, CPAN! Linda works at Hendrick Medical Center, has been nursing for about 33 years. She has been an ASPAN member for nearly 12 years and has been a certified perianesthesia nurse for almost as long. Prior to recovery room nursing, Linda's experience includes medsurg, neuro, and orthopedic areas. She has been a PACU nurse for a total of 27 years.

Linda has seen some big changes since she was a baby nurse. She remembers when being on call for PACU was a one person job. These days, at her facility, there are always 2 nurses on call overnight and on weekends. Since she started in PACU, she has noticed a higher volume of outpatient surgeries and a wider variety of patient ages. When she first came to PACU, the patient population was mostly inpatient.

Linda says "[We] are always learning something new" as technology and procedures advance. She has learned to adapt and be more flexible. She has had to keep up with guidelines for care of the wide age range of patients. Taking care of more outpatients, she has become adept at education and documentation for discharge.

One of her favorite things about working in PACU is the variety of patients and surgeries.

Working with her, one can see her years of experience working simultaneously to make decisions to best care for her patients. While she may not agree, hopefully, she will not retire anytime in the near future. Thank you Linda, for all of your hard work and willingness to share your knowledge with others!
