

I Remember That! – Using Gamification to Improve Knowledge Retention with PeriOp Staff Speakers: Kayla Haugen, MS, BSN, RN, CPN and Karen Johnson, MSN, RN, CNOR

This was a great educational session! With it being a hands-on experience, participation in the audience was highly achieved. The simulation activity that created the hands-on learning experience was the Relay Races for the Airway Train. Staff had to assist the Anesthesiologists with reintubation and securing the airway, which includes the blade, ET tube, stylet and Magill forceps. The Relay consisted of two teams who each had, 10 minutes to build the train and patient scenario cards with supplies provided at the foot of the bed. Once your train was completed with the appropriate supplies needed for the tasks, the conductor blew the whistle. Examples were given for other Relay Race challenges, such as Family Feud, and Malignant Hyperthermia Escape Rooms.

We have previously created a Malignant Hyperthermia Escape room for our perioperative team. Attending these educational sessions, provides opportunity for improvement on our current training plans. With this information, I plan to create a more challenging Malignant Hyperthermia Escape room and will implement more Relay challenges. Such as, the Belmont Relay for Blood set-ups. This creates a better experience for the learner with more opportunity to meeting the desirable learning outcomes.


